Vietnamese American Scholastic Achievement Awards

The Vietnamese American Scholastic Achievement Awards (VASAA) Committee is pleased to announce the following scholarships for 2024-2025. The purpose of these scholarships is to assist and empower Vietnamese-Americans to become future leaders through education, leadership, community involvement and civic engagement. In this effort, various scholarships are being offered to Vietnamese-American college and high school students who demonstrate meritorious academic achievement, leadership, and/or community service.

❖ American Furniture Galleries (AFG) Community Service, Leadership and Academic Excellence Scholarship for College Student

(2 scholarships available; \$1,000 for each recipient)

Applicant must be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident and a Vietnamese-American student currently attending an accredited community college or university in Sacramento County or vicinity; have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 and one year of community service experience; demonstrate leadership ability; submit a minimum one to two- page typed essay describing your involvement in the community, what you have learned from your involvement, and your vision of how to build a strong Vietnamese-American community; provide a minimum of two references (must be a counselor/teacher/supervisor/community leader); submit a scholarship application by July 26, 2025.

❖ American Furniture Galleries (AFG) High School Academic Excellence and Leadership Scholarship
(2 scholarships available; \$500 for each recipient)

Applicant must be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident and a Vietnamese-American student currently attending high school in Sacramento County or vicinity; have a minimum GPA of 4.0; have at least one year of experience in high school extracurricular activities and/or community service; demonstrate leadership ability; write a one page personal statement describing your leadership ability and what you have learned from your community or school involvement experience; provide two references (must be a school counselor/teacher, supervisor/community leader); submit a scholarship application by July 26, 2025.

❖ American Furniture Galleries (AFG) Top High School Student Scholarship
(4 scholarships available; \$250 for each recipient)

Applicant must be a a U.S. citizen or permanent resident and a Vietnamese-American high school student in Sacramento County or vicinity; eligible for the 2024-2025 Vietnamese American Scholastic Achievement Award; have the highest grade point average for the 2024-2025 grade level. (Note: Scholarship application is NOT required.)

❖ Dương Phan Memorial Scholarship

(2 scholarships available for Middle School students; \$200 for each student)

Applicant must be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident and a Vietnamese-American Middle School student in Sacramento County or vicinity; eligible for the 2024-2025 Vietnamese American Scholastic Achievement Award; have the highest grade point average for the 2024-2025 grade level. (Note: Scholarship application is NOT required.)

❖ Nguyễn Đặng Memorial Scholarship

(1 scholarship available; \$300)

Applicant must be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident and a Vietnamese-American high school student in Sacramento County or vicinity; eligible for the 2024-2025 Vietnamese American Scholastic Achievement Award; have a minimum 4.0 grade point average for the 2024-2025 academic year; have at least one year of high school extracurricular activity involvement or community service experience; write a one to two-page essay describing what you have learned from your high school and/or community involvement experience; submit a scholarship application by July 26, 2025.
